- Our team of editors will help review your article to make sure that it's really great

- Please note that this is unpaid, and any contributions will be on a voluntary basis

Submitting An Article

It's great that you are interested in writing for us! If you have an idea, please contact one of our editors first or email editor@themarinediaries.com with either an outline or partial draft to make sure that it aligns with our interests.

Your editor will ask the following questions:

- ♥ Does the article suit The Marine Diaries and its audience?
- ▼ Is the article correct and giving current information?
- ▼ Is the content original work?

How to Format

Once your idea has been approved by us, please submit your article to editor@themarinediaries.com. Your assigned editor will be your key contact, so if any problems or questions arise, you can email them at the above email address.

- ♥ Submissions for our blog section should be between 400-600 words (no rambling please!)
- For a longer feature article please contact us
- ♥ Please submit an editable word document to us
- Include reference links for all facts, data and scientific papers cited.
- Please send us any videos or images in <u>high resolution</u> images need to be photos that you own the copyright to, no copy and paste from google images! If you do not any photos, let us know and we can include one of ours.

After your draft has been submitted, the editorial team will get back to you with any feedback/notes. When the edited final version has been approved, we will schedule the article to be published and inform you of the date. We would appreciate it if you could **share the link** to the article on your social media.

Publishing Policy

What We Will and Will Not Publish

We follow a number of guidelines before we publish an article on The Marine Diaries. Every article published by us has to fulfill certain criteria. To protect the interests of our readers we want to ensure that the quality of our content remains high. Therefore, every article is reviewed by at least two of our editors before it is published on site.

- We will not publish any material that is in any way offensive or derogatory or contains offensive language.
- We don't have any hidden advertisements. Any sponsored articles are marked as such.
- We do not influence our writers' opinions to fit our own personal interests/opinions.
- We respect the rights of authors and photographers. Content found on The Marine Diaries is there with the written consent of the creator.
